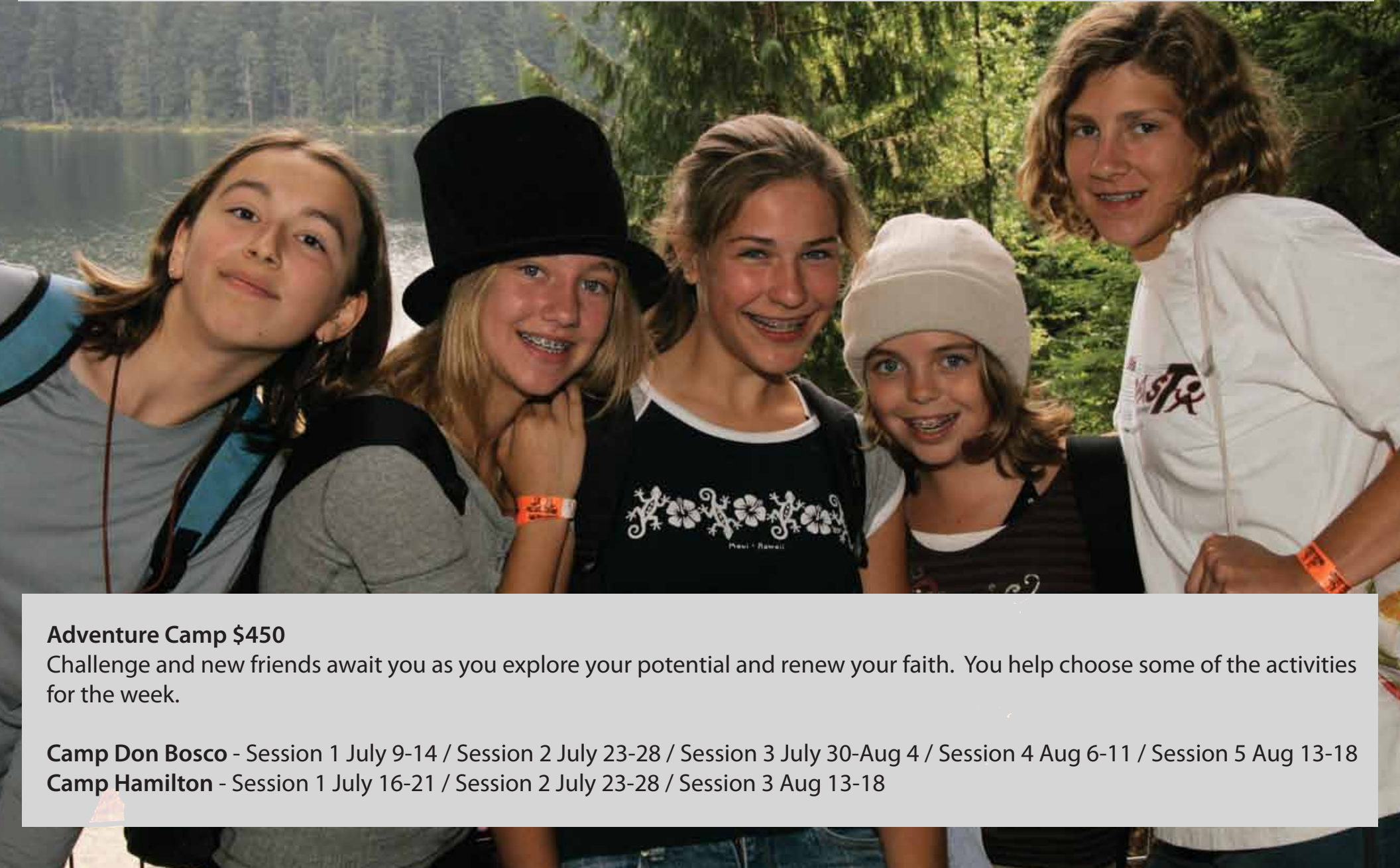


Resident Camp Grades 6-9
