

Horse Camp

Immerse yourself in horsemanship and the cowboy lifestyle. A horse will be assigned to you for the week and our experienced staff will help you improve your balance, learn safe riding and how to care for horses. Campers are assigned to riding groups based on skill. Each group will spend 1 1/2 - 2 hours at the corral each day. Boots with a 3/4 inch heel and smooth sole are required.

Horsin' Around: Grades 1-8

Grades 1-2: Learn how to be comfortable around horses and the basics in the arena and on the ground. Most campers will be led.

Grades 3-5: Start out in the arena learning basics at the walk. You'll also learn the basics of horse care. As campers advanced they may go on trail rides and trot.

Grades 6-8: Learn the basics of safe horseback riding or expand on previous knowledge. Improve your balance and control at the walk and trot in the arena and on a trail ride. Campers will learn how to groom, saddle, and other ground lessons.

Resident Horse Camp Grades 3-9

Trail Scouts Grades 3-5: Campers will work on balance at the walk as they play games in the arena. As campers advanced they may go on trail rides and trot. Learn basic horse care and other fun facts.

Appaloosa Grades 6-9: Learn the basics of safe horseback riding or expand on previous knowledge. Improve your balance and control at the walk and trot in the arena and on a trail ride. Campers will learn how to groom, saddle, and other ground lessons.

Wrangler Grades 6-9 (*intermediate or advanced, 2 or more years experience required*): In this advanced program campers will groom and saddle their own horse each day. Through games and trail rides campers learn balance and control at the trot and can advance to the lope. Ground lessons cover breeds, markings, and horse health.
